Safety Helmet	Required by law-reflectORIZATION required
State Funded Rider Ed	Available for all eligible applicants-required under age 18
Eye Protection	Required by law unless equipped with windscreen
Daytime Use of Headlight	No Restriction
Passenger Seat	Required if carrying a passenger
Passenger Footrest	Required if carrying a passenger
Passenger Age Restriction	None
Helmet Speakers	Single earphone only
Periodic Safety Inspection	Required by law-upon title transfer
Mirror Left(L) Right(R)	Required by law (L,R)
Radar Detector	No Restriction
Turn Signals	Required by law
Muffler	Muffler required.
Maximum Sound Level	Maximum allowable A-weighted sound levels based on measurement distance of 50 feet (Sec. 11.14.07.04): 1)After 7/1/75 82-86dBA 2)after 1/1/79 78-82dBA.
State Insurance Requirements	Compulsory Liability (Minimum Limits)(20/40/10)
Handlebar Height	Maximum of 15" above seat
